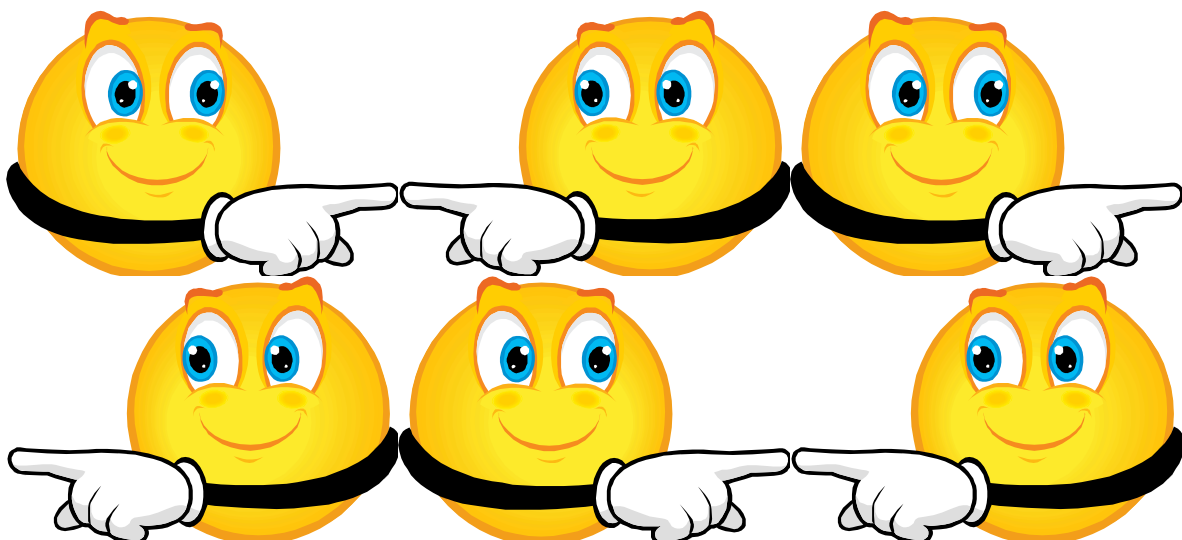

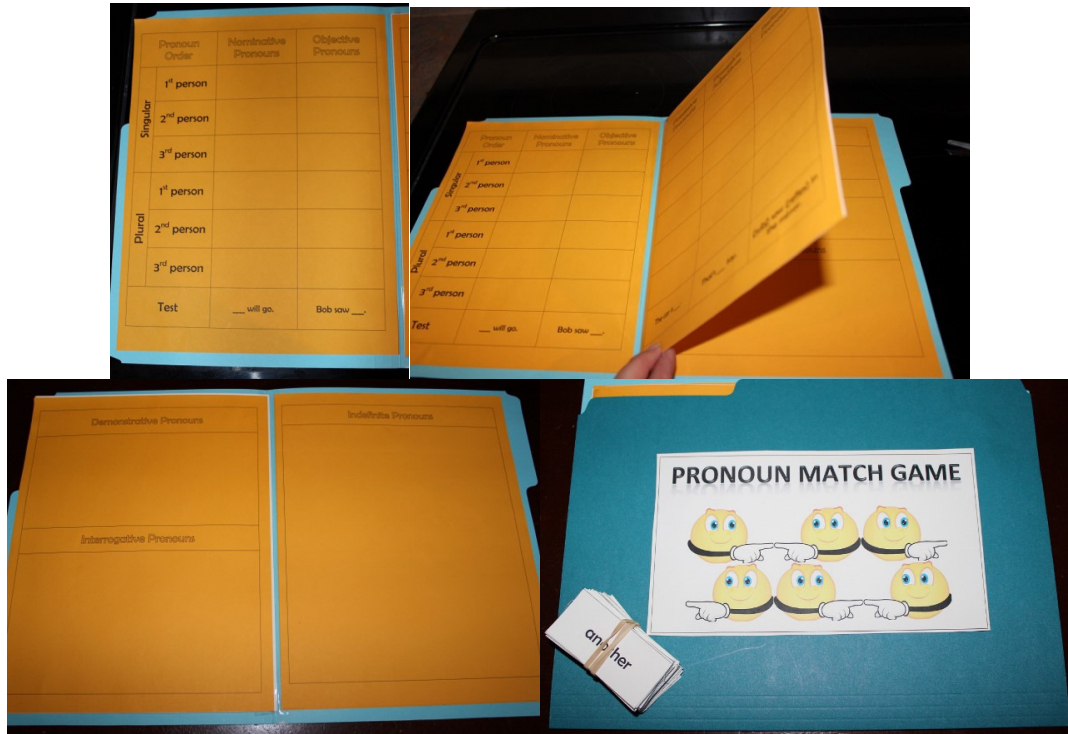
PRONOUN MATCH GAME



Pronoun Match Game

Materials Needed: file folder, tape, glue, scissors, 7 sheets of cardstock (any color), printer

Print & Assembly Instructions: Print page 1 and 2 on cardstock paper. Print page 3 on the back side of page 2. Print pages 4-8 on cardstock paper. Paste page 1 onto left side of file folder. Tape page 2-3 inside file folder along one edge. Paste page 4 onto right side of file folder. Cut out all pronoun cards (pages 5-8). Cut out file folder game title and paste to outside of file folder.



To play: Student matches cards to the correct spot. After mastery, you may cover up the “Test” part of the table to pose a greater challenge.
