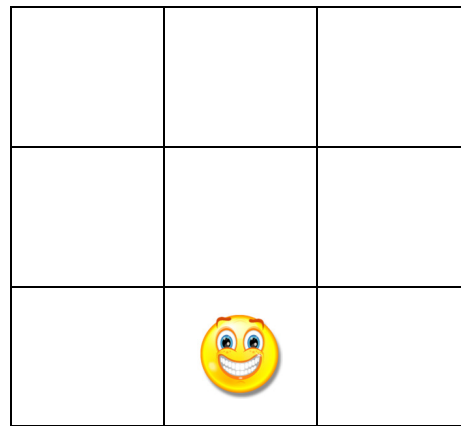
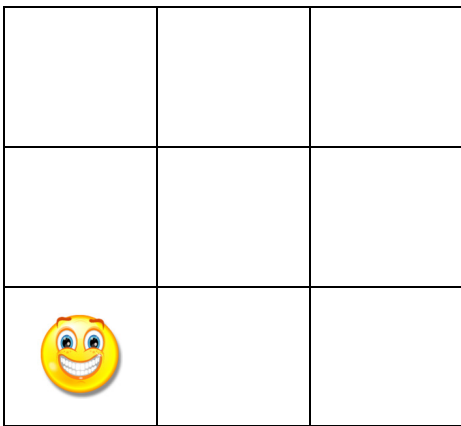
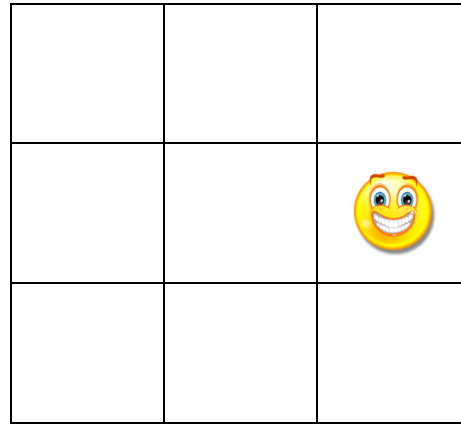
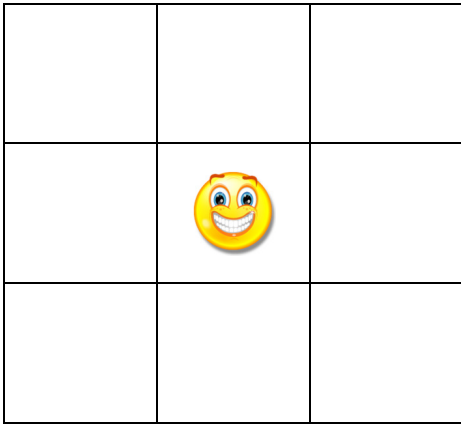
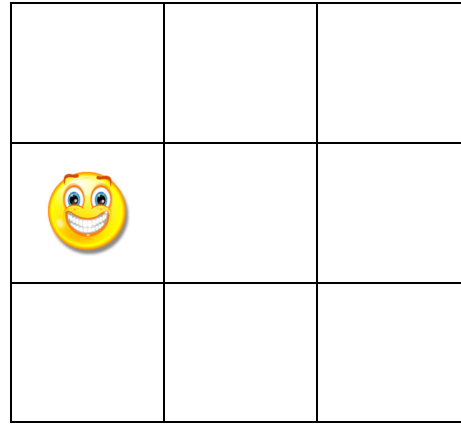
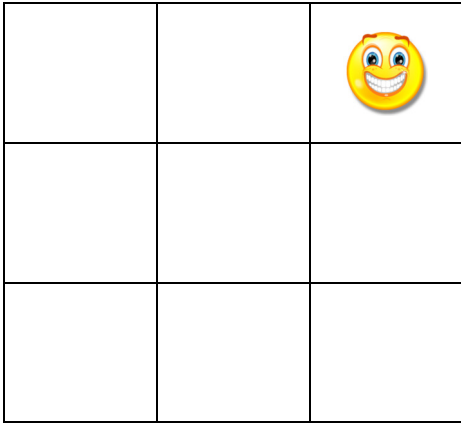
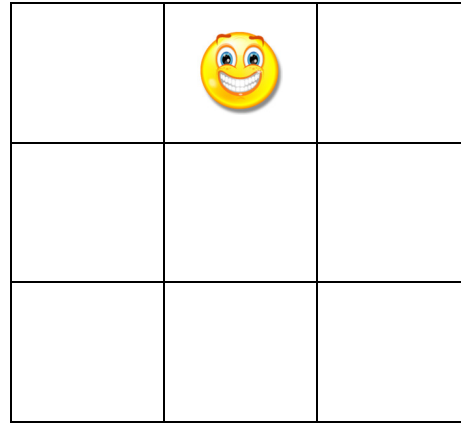
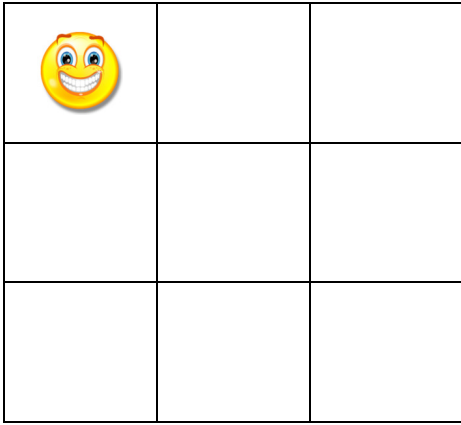




Fill er up Instructions: Give each student a copy of a blank “fill-er-up gameboard” (3x3 square), or have student draw a tic-tac-toe symbol with a box around it on a blank sheet of paper (dividing the paper up into nine sections). After a student answers a question, have all of the students write a number 1-9 in one of the sections. After all nine boxes are full (each with a different number), select one of the smiley fill-er-up gameboards from a baggie. The student with the highest number in that box wins.

Black out – Use the same blank gameboards and pre-made answer cards as in Fill-Er-Up. Before asking questions have the students fill each space with numbers 1-9 anywhere on the gameboard. Ask a question, draw out one of your answer gamecards. They need to black that space out on their board. Repeat the "question...black out space" pattern until everyone has one spot is left. Whoever has the largest number in that spot wins.

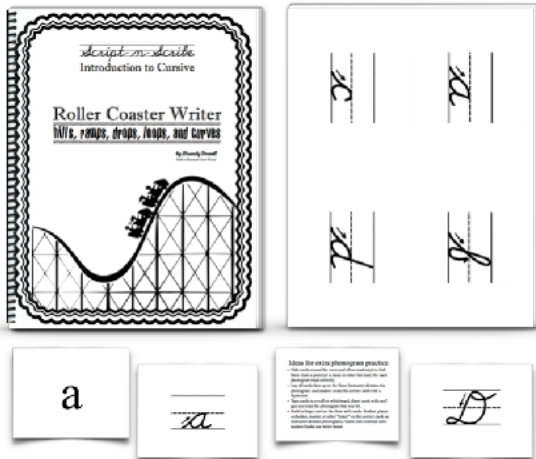
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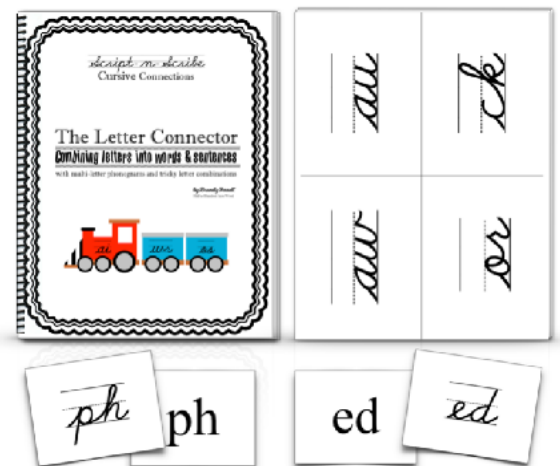
