## Can of Wiggly Worms

Set-up: Print and laminate. Cut along solid lines. Glue each subject/worm to the end of a popsicle stick and place upside down in a coffee or tin can. (Print more than one copy for several more popsicle sticks if desired.)

Instructions: Students sit in a circle with can in the middle. At a turn, the student pulls a stick out of the can. If they get a subject, the entire class answers the question together for that subject. If they get a worm, every student stands up and wiggles like a worm. (Also can be played so that student has to answer question individually.) Return the subjects back to the can after each turn unless the previous six weeks' memory work has been completed for that subject.
