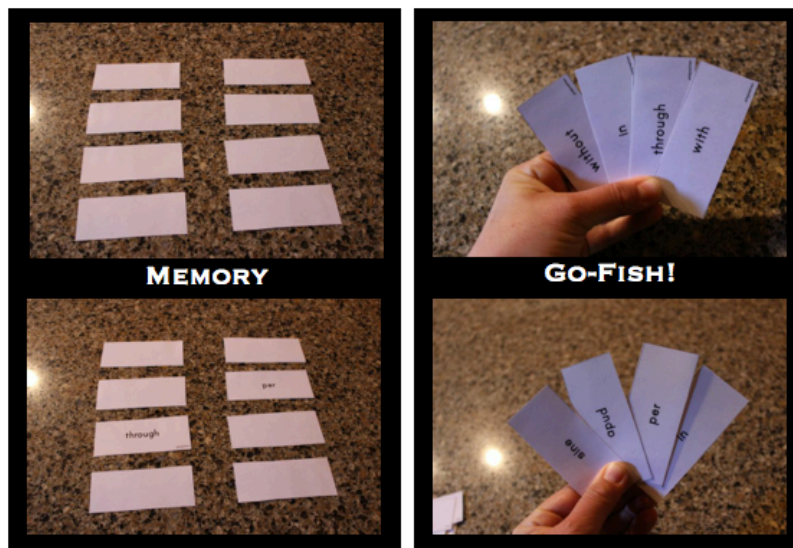


John 1 Latin Flashcards and Flashcard Games

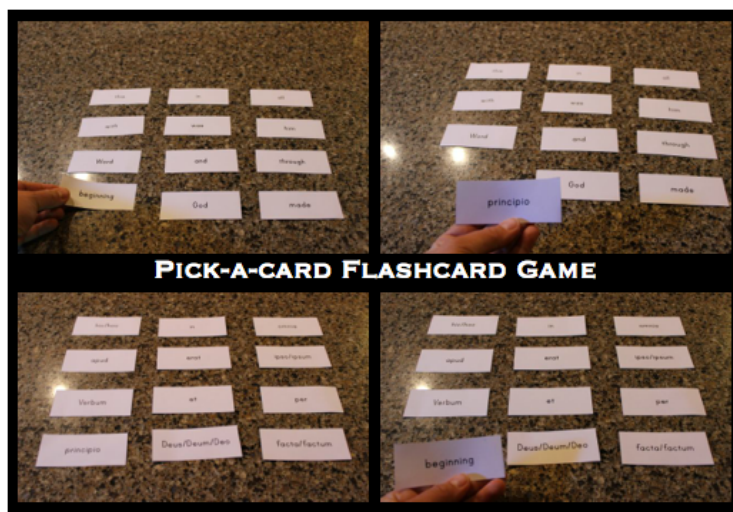


The following are games to play with the **Latin and English words on separate cards**.



Memory. Set out all cards face down. Turn over two at a time to see if they make a match. If not, turn them back over, and it's the other person's turn.

Go-Fish! Pardon me, do you have a "sine"? (Either the person asking the question translates the word when asking, or the person being asked has to think about what the word means.) This is usually good to use after several words have been introduced so that you can have more cards in your deck! Pick-a-card Flashcard Game. Lay out all cards. Students select a card, translate the word, and flip the card to see if they are correct.

The flashcards in this document were made to be printed on the reverse side: Page 5 on back of 4, Page 7 on back of 6, etc. (I've added a few extra vocabulary words on the last page to fill out the John 1 passage.)
