

Oral Question Confirmation Drill for Question #1 & Question #2:

Creating the habit of asking the question confirmation questions.

Question #1: “Who or What [*verb*] ?” Label *SN* or *SP*.

Question #2: “What is being said about [*subject*]?” Label *V*.

Example Sentence: Levi painted.

Question Confirmation #1 & #2: Who or what painted? **Levi** painted. Label *SN*. What is being said about Levi? Levi **painted**. Label *V*.

Drill orally:

Oral Question Confirmation Drill for Question #1 – Question #4:

Creating the habit of asking the question confirmation questions.

Question #1: “Who or What [verb] ?” Label **SN** or **SP**.

Question #2: “What is being said about [subject]?” Label **V**.

Question #3: “[Subject] [verb] what or whom?” If there is no answer, label verb **Vi**. If there is an answer here, ask:

Question #4: “Can [noun/pronoun] rename [subject] or does [adj.] describe [subject]?” If “yes,” label **PN** or **PA** appropriately & label **VI**. If “no,” label **DO** and the verb as **Vt**.

Example Sentence: Levi painted a masterpiece.

Question Confirmation #1 & #2: Who or what painted? **Levi** painted. Label **SN**. What is being said about Levi? Levi **painted**. Label **V**.

Question #3 & 4: Levi painted what or whom? Levi painted a **masterpiece**. “Can masterpiece rename Levi or does masterpiece describe Levi?” No. Label as **DO** and verb as **Vt**. (“a” is an article adjective, so label **AJ**.)

Drill orally:
