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
Karl Bodmer (1809-1893)

During a German expedition on the Missouri River in the 1830s, Swiss-French Painter Karl Bodmer was hired as an artist to record images of towns, rivers, and peoples, including the many tribes of Native Americans along the Missouri River and surrounding area. He is best known in the United States for his accurate depictions of the inhabitants and landscape of the American West.



C. M. Russell (1864-1926)

Known as the “cowboy artist,” American artist, sculptor, storyteller, and author Charles Marion Russell created more than 2,000 paintings of cowboys, Indians, and landscapes set in the Old American West.




Frederic Remington (1861-1909)

Frederic Remington was an American painter, illustrator, sculptor, and writer who is best known for his depictions of the Old American West, featuring images of cowboys, American Indians, and the U.S. Cavalry.



Albert Bierstadt (1830-1902)

American painter Albert Bierstadt was best known for his glowing landscapes of the American West. His detailed paintings depict a style featuring lighting called luminism.
